



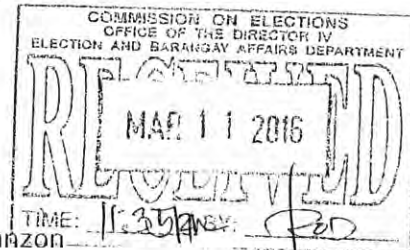

**IN THE MATTER OF THE INCLUSION IN THE LIST OF VOTERS
AND CORRECTION OF RECORDS IN THE DATABASE**

This pertains to the Memorandum dated February 26, 2016 of Deputy Executive Director for Operations Bartolome J. Sinocruz, Jr. relative to the Memorandum dated January 29, 2016 of EBAD Director Teopisto E. Elnas, Jr. on the inclusion in the List of Voters and correction of records in the database.

The Memorandum of Director Sinocruz reads:

"This refers to the two (2) Memoranda of EBAD Director Teopisto E. Elnas, Jr., one dated January 22, 2016 and the other one, dated January 29, 2016.

The Memoranda pertain to requests for inclusion in the list of voters and correction of records in the database, by Election Officers of several cities/municipalities. It was noted by the undersigned that the 2nd Memorandum (dated January 29, 2016) pertains to the same several requests mentioned in the 1st Memorandum (dated January 22, 2016) with the addition in Item 'A' of the following:

- 1) Memorandum dated January 23, 2016 of Rosalinda A. Albia-Radin for the inclusion of twelve (12) voters enumerated therein whose registration records were not included in the consolidation from the stand-alone server to the main Voter's Registration System (VRS) server in the said office; and*
- 2) Memorandum dated January 11, 2016 of Atty. Ainee K. Tañeza, Election Officer of Talisay City, Negros Occidental for the inclusion of the names of Mr. Felix Calansingin Alit in the list of voters. Per ITD Memorandum dated January 14, 2016, the Audit Logs of the VRS of Talisay City revealed that Mr. Alit applied for correction of entry of his maternal name and undergo validation process. However, Mr. Alit records was included in the deactivation process last November 16, 2015 ERB Hearing.*

In both Memoranda, Director Elnas manifested that the Commission has already approved on December 5, 2015 the Project of Precincts for the May 9, 2016 National and Local Elections and that the pertinent data (SNPDAT) were already uploaded in the voting system.

However, Director Elnas believes that the non-inclusion of the names of voters mentioned in Item 'A' who were found to have biometrics data would result to undue deprivation of their right of suffrage in the forthcoming elections and that the correction of records mentioned in Item 'B' would not affect the total number of registered voters in the said municipalities.

In the 1st Memorandum, Director Elnas recommended for the inclusion of the aforementioned voters enumerated in Item 'A' and to allow the EOs concerned in Item 'B' to make the necessary correction in the database in their respective city/municipality. In the 2nd Memorandum, he made the same recommendations but already tabulated.

This Office concurs with the recommendations of EBAD Director Teopisto E. Elnas, Jr. with further recommendation that the [Information Technology Department] (ITD) prepare a supplemental list for those voters whose registration records were reinstated in the database after December 15, 2015, considering that the Project of Precincts for the forthcoming elections was already approved last December 15, 2015.

The Memorandum of Director Elnas states:

"This pertains to the following concerns raised by the following Offices of the Election Officers (OEOs) as follows:

- A. Requesting for the inclusion of the names of the concerned voters in their respective area of responsibilities.
 1. Memorandum of Dr. Arnulfo A. Aguilar, Election Officer IV, 2nd District, Manila dated January 16, 2016 requesting that the name of **Mrs. Nenita Gaspay Conception** of Barangay 210 Precinct 0851 be included in the list of the voters of the said city which was inadvertently not encoded/updated in the database. Based on the attached supporting documents Mrs. Conception was registered as voter last June 15, 1997. She applied for the reactivation of her registration records on July 21, 2014 and was approved by the Election Registration Board on October 24, 2014. However, the ERB approval was not effected in the local voters' database;
 2. Memorandum of Rosalinda A. Albia-Radin dated January 23, 2016 for the inclusion of twelve (12) voters enumerated therein whose registration records were not included in the consolidation from the stand-alone server to the main Voter's Registration System (VRS) server in the said office;
 3. Memorandum of EOIII Magdiell C. Oallares of Kawit, Cavite, requesting to undelete the registration records of seventy-five (75) voters due to corrupted files but whose registration records were deactivated for failure to undergo validation. The said Memorandum was endorsed to the Information Technology Department (ITD) for verification. In reply, ITD confirmed that out of 75 records only the registration record of a certain **Mrs. Teodora Arguelles Ignacio** was found to have biometrics data in the database but was included in the deactivation process last November 16, 2015 ERB hearing;

4. Memorandum of OIC-EO Jimmy S. Tafalla of Magallanes, Cavite, requesting to undelete the registration records of ninety-nine (99) voters due to corrupted files but whose registration records were deactivated for failure to undergo validation. The Memorandum was endorsed to the Information Technology Department (ITD) for verification. In reply, ITD confirmed that out of 99 voters only the registration records of **Messrs. Ronald Venus Federez and Pablito Escorido Dinco** were found to have biometrics data in the database but were included in the deactivation process last November 16, 2015 ERB hearing. However, the name of Mr. Ronald Venus Federez is not among those listed in the request of EO Tafalla but it refers to the father of the Ronald Romaito Federez, Jr.
 5. Memorandum of Atty. Sheryl G. Moresca, Election Officer IV, Bacoor City referring to the Election and Barangay Affairs Department the four thousand seven hundred ninety-six (4,796) registration records that were deactivated last November 16, 2015 ERB hearing due to the absence of their biometrics information in the database. In the same memorandum, Atty. Moresca categorically stated that the registration records of the 4,796 voters were corrupted. For this reason, the matter was endorsed to the Information Technology Department (ITD) for verification. In reply, ITD confirmed that out of 4,796 records only the registration records of **Maureen Maxell San Jose Rival, Imelda Esguerra Jalos and Merlin Jao Duritan** were found to have biometrics data in the database but were included in the deactivation process last November 16, 2015 ERB hearing; and
 6. Memorandum of Atty. Ainee K. Tañeza, Election Officer of Talisay City, Negros Occidental for the inclusion of the name of **Mr. Felix Calansingin Alit** in the list of voters. Per ITD Memorandum dated January 14, 2016, the Audit Logs of the VRS of Talisay City revealed that Mr. Alit applied for correction of entry of his maternal name and undergo validation process. However, Mr. Alit records was included in the deactivation process last November 16, 2015 ERB hearing.
- B. Correction of precinct assignment and barangay in the database to reflect the correct information written in the Voter's Registration Record.
1. Memorandum of Atty. Imelda A. Panis, Election Officer, San Jose del Monte, Bulacan to correct the barangay address of Ms. Anelli Faith Vargas Benito from Barangay Muzon to Barangay Ciudad Real of the said city;
 2. Memorandum of EO Gilbert Z. Palogan, Hagonoy, Bulacan for the correction of precincts/barangay assignments of fifty-six (56) registered voters in the said municipality; and
 3. Memoranda of Francisco T. Rosal, Jr., Cainta, Rizal, for the correction of precinct assignment of four voters in the said municipality.

As of December 15, [2015], the Commission En Banc has approved the Projects of Precincts for the May 9, 2016 National and Local Election and that pertinent data (SNPDAT) were already uploaded in the voting system.

However, the Department sees that the non inclusion of the names of voters mentioned in Item 'A' who were found to have biometrics data would result to undue deprivation of their right of suffrage in the forth coming elections. And that the correction of records mentioned in Item 'B' would not affect the total number of registered voters in the said municipalities.

For this reason, this Department hereby recommends for the inclusion of the aforementioned voters enumerated in Item 'A' and to allow the EOs concerned in Item 'B' to make the necessary correction in the database in their respective city/municipality, as follows:


