**MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY ACT NO. 203**

Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday, the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October, two thousand six.

**AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN ENGINEERING DISTRICT  
IN THE PROVINCE OF MAGUINDANAO,  
PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.**

Be it enacted by the Regional Assembly in session assembled:

**Section 1.** - There is hereby established an Engineering District in the Province of Maguindanao, which shall automatically function and operate upon the creation of the Province of Shariff Kabunsuan.

**Sec. 2.** - The organization and structure of the engineering district shall be the same with any engineering district in the ARMM or in the country with a staffing pattern and plantilla of personnel.

It shall be headed by a District Engineer with an Assistant District Engineer who shall both be appointed by the Regional Governor upon the recommendation by the DPWH-ARMM Secretary; subject to Civil Service Law, rules and regulations.

The ARMM, being a local government under the Constitution, PD No. 336 or career executive service officer eligibility for appointment shall not apply.

**Sec. 3.** - As established, the engineering district shall operate under the control and supervision of the DPWH-ARMM for the entire network of roads or highways and public works under its jurisdiction.

It shall, however, submit an annual maintenance program prior to the start of each fiscal year for the entire public highways and public works in the district for approval by the DPWH-ARMM Secretary which shall be endorsed by the Regional Governor to DPWH Secretary of the national government for funding assistance.

**Sec. 4.** - The district shall be entitled to per centum of funds for each project for administrative purposes as fixed by law.

**Sec. 5.** - Except as may be provided by law, the district shall have under its jurisdiction the entire remaining area of the province of Maguindanao.

**Sec. 6.** - Provisions of existing and relevant laws, rules and regulations not heretofore provided shall be supplementary in the implementation of this Act.

**Sec. 7.** - Pending the organization of the district, the Regional Governor shall, upon recommendation by the DPWH-ARMM Secretary, temporarily set up an office by executive order in the area.

**Sec. 8.** - The assets and liabilities between the original and new engineering districts, including appropriations and capital equipment, shall be apportioned on a sixty and forty percentages basis as may be determined by a joint committee.

**Sec. 9.** - Such funds as may be necessary as determined and recommended by the DPWH-ARMM Secretary for approval by the Regional Treasurer out of any available funds in the Regional Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for initial operation of the engineering district is hereby authorized. Thereafter, its regular annual appropriations shall be included in the appropriations of the DPWH-ARMM.

**Sec. 10.** - This Act shall take effect upon approval.
