Begun and held in Cotabato City, on Monday, the twenty-sixth day of October, two thousand and eight.

**AN ACT TO REPEAL MUSLIM MINDANAO AUTONOMY  
ACT NUMBERED 174 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


Be it enacted by the Regional Assembly in session assembled:

**SECTION. 1.** Muslim Mindanao Autonomy Act No. 174, which divided the Schools Division of Sulu into two (2) divisions is hereby repealed and restored to one schools division.

**“SEC. 2.** As abolished all the assets and liabilities of then Second Schools Division in the aforesaid province are transferred and/or restored to the Lone Schools Division of Sulu immediately after the approval of this Act.”


**SEC.3.** This Act shall take effect upon its publication in a newspaper of regional circulation in the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao.
