EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 522

DECLARING THE LUMBAN BRIDGE IN THE PROVINCE OF LAGUNA AS A NATIONAL TOLL BRIDGE AND FIXING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR THE COLLECTION OF TOLLS THEREON.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 5 of Commonwealth Act No. 330, and upon recommendation of the Secretary of Public Works and Communications, I, ELPIDIO QUIRINO, President of the Philippines, do hereby declare the Lumban Bridge in the province of Laguna as a national toll bridge and direct that the following tolls be collected thereon effective as of August 1, 1949:

1. Truck, bus, weapons or personnel carrier, tractor or trailer ..... ₱ 0.50
2. Automobile, pick-up, jitney (converted) with maximum capacity of 11 passengers, jeep or jeepney ..... 0.25
3. Motorcycle ..... 0.10

The proceeds derived from the collection of tolls as herein provided for shall be applied to the repair and maintenance of Lumban Toll Bridge.

Done in the City of Manila, this 7th day of August, in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-two, and of the Independence of the Philippines, the seventh.
