PROCLAMATION NO. 238

DECLARING SATURDAY, DECEMBER 31, 1955, AS A SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY.

WHEREAS, the thirtieth day (Friday) of December, 1955, and the first day (Sunday) of January, 1956, being holidays, the thirtieth day (Saturday) of December, 1955, may be declared a special public holiday to enable the people to enjoy an uninterrupted Christmas holiday without prejudice to the public interest;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RAMON MACKAY, President of the Philippines, in virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 30 of the Revised Administrative Code, do hereby proclaim Saturday, December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, as a special public holiday.
