PROCLAMATION No. 313

MAKING PUBLIC THE PROTOCOL SIGNED AT LAKE
SUCCESS, NEW YORK, ON DECEMBER 11, 1946,

AMENDING THE AGREEMENTS, CONVENTIONS,
AND PROTOCOLS ON NARCOTIC DRUGS CON-
CLUDED AT THE HAGUE ON 23 JANUARY 1912,
AT GENEVA ON 11 FEBRUARY 1925, 19 FEB-
RUARY 1925, AND 13 JULY 1931, AT BANGKOK
ON 27 NOVEMBER 1931, AND AT GENEVA ON
26 JUNE 1936

WHEREAS, a Protocol was signed at Lake Success, New York, on December 11, 1946, amending the agreements, conventions, and protocols on narcotic drugs concluded at the Hague on 23 January 1912, at Geneva on 11 February 1925, 19 February 1925, and 13 July 1931, at Bangkok on 27 November 1931, and at Geneva on 26 June 1936.

WHEREAS, the Senate of the Congress of the Philip-
pines, by its Resolution No. 92, adopted on May 17, 1949,
concurred in the acceptance of the aforesaid Protocol in
accordance with the Constitution of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the said Protocol was duly accepted by the
President of the Philippines and the instrument of ac-
ceptance of the Government of the Republic of the Phil-
ippines was deposited with the Secretary-General of the
United Nations on May 25, 1950; and

WHEREAS, the said Protocol became effective in respect
of the Philippines on May 25, 1950;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it known that I, Ramon Magsaysay,
President of the Philippines, have caused the present
Protocol, a copy of which is hereto attached, to be made
public to the end that the same and every article and
clause thereof may be observed and fulfilled with good
faith by the Republic of the Philippines and the citizens
thereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and
caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be
affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 10th day of July, in
the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and fifty-six, and
of the Independence of the Philippines, the eleventh.
