PROCLAMATION NO. 21

DECLARING TUESDAY, AUGUST 19, 1986, AS A NON-WORKING SPECIAL PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN QUEZON PROVINCE, LUCENA CITY AND QUEZON CITY.


WHEREAS, the 108th birth anniversary of the late President Manuel L. Quezon falls on Tuesday, August 19, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the people of Quezon Province, his birthplace, including Lucena City and the city named after him should be given full opportunity to render homage to the memory of our illustrious leader, patriot, statesman and one of the ablest men this country has produced;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, CORAZON C. AQUINO, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare Tuesday, August 19, 1986, as a non-working special public holiday in Quezon Province, Lucena City and Quezon City.
