

BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES

PROCLAMATION NO. 192

EXCLUDING FROM THE OPERATION OF PROCLAMATION NO. 24, DATED DECEMBER 1, 1945, WHICH ESTABLISHED THE BATAAN NATIONAL PARK RESERVATION SITUATED IN THE MUNICIPALITIES OF HERMOSA, ORANI, SAMAL, ABUCAY, BALANGA, PILAR, BAGAC AND MORONG, PROVINCE OF BATAAN AND MUNICIPALITY OF SUBIC, PROVINCE OF ZAMBALES, A CERTAIN PORTION OF THE LAND EMBRACED THEREIN, AND DECLARING THE SAME AS KANAWAN NEGRITOS RESERVATION AREA

Upon the recommendation of the Secretary of Environment and Natural Resources and pursuant to the provisions of Section 84 of the Public Land Act (Commonwealth Act No. 141), as amended, I, CORAZON C. AQUINO, President of the Philippines, do hereby exclude from the operation of Proclamation No. 24, dated December 1, 1945, which established the Bataan National Park Reservation situated in the Municipalities of Hermosa, Orani, Samal, Abucay, Balanga, Pilar, Bagac and Morong, Province of Bataan and in the Municipality of Subic, Province of Zambales, a certain portion of the land embraced therein situated in the Municipality of Morong, Province of Bataan and declare the same as KANAWAN NEGRITOS RESERVATION AREA for the exclusive use and benefit of Negritos actually occupying and/or residing therein, which portion is more particularly described as follows:

"Beginning at a point marked '1' on the sketch map which is S 80° E, 1998.0 meters from BLIM-11, Morong Cadastre:

Thence N 75⁰30'W, 135 meters to corner 24;
Thence N 75⁰30'W, 204 meters to corner 25;
Thence S 87⁰45'W, 242 meters to corner 26;
Thence S 87⁰45'W, 208 meters to corner 27;
Thence N 75⁰15'W, 200 meters to corner 28;
Thence N 75⁰15'W, 250 meters to corner 29;
Thence N 75⁰15'W, 160 meters to corner 30;
Thence N 75⁰15'W, 190 meters to corner 31;
Thence N 23⁰30'E, 100 meters to corner 32;
Thence N 23⁰30'E, 155 meters to corner 33;
Thence N 15⁰45'E, 200 meters to corner 34;
Thence N 15⁰45'E, 210 meters to corner 1,

the point of beginning, containing an area of One Hundred Sixty-Five (165) hectares more or less, subject to private rights if any there be, as well as to future survey and delimitation, and to the following conditions:

1. The administration and management of the area covered by the reservation shall be jointly under the Department of Environment and Natural Resources and the Office of Northern Cultural Communities. For this purpose the said agencies are hereby authorized to call upon the assistance and support of other agencies in the execution of plans and programs for the development of the area, taking into consideration existing government development programs with respect to water, soil and forest conservation, including the cultural and traditional customs and practices of the Aeta Tribe.

2. A development plan of the reservation shall be prepared and submitted to the Office of the President not later than six (6) months from the promulgation hereof.

3. The disposition of the area with respect to land tenure shall be pursued under the stewardship concept, and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, through the Forest Management Bureau, is hereby directed to implement immediately the integrated social forestry program within the

area such that only qualified members of the Aeta Tribe, upon the recommendation of the Office of Northern Cultural Communities, may forthwith receive their certificates of stewardship.

4. All timber licenses, minor forest products licenses and pasture lease agreements as may be operating within the reservation are hereby cancelled, revoked or amended accordingly. The Department of Environment and Natural Resources, shall furnish the Office of Northern Cultural Communities a listing of concessionaires and licensees whose permits/licenses are to be affected by this Proclamation.

5. The utilization of all timber and other minor forest products found therein shall be subject to the forest and revenue laws, rules and regulations which now or may hereafter be in force.


6. This Proclamation shall be deemed automatically revoked or cancelled in the event that the reservation no longer serves the purpose for which it was originally established and/or has been abandoned by the intended beneficiaries, and the area declared covered thereby be forthwith reserved to the mass of forest lands under the administration and management of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources through the Forest Management Bureau.
