**DECLARING FRIDAY, DECEMBER 4, 1992, ON THE OCCASION OF THE  
SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN ELECTIONS.**

WHEREAS, Friday, December 4, 1992, was set as the Sangguniang Kabataan General Election; and


WHEREAS, there is a need to give our youth full opportunity to participate in this election.

The various local government units through their respective Chief Local Executives shall extend all possible assistance and support to ensure the smooth conduct of the general elections.


