PROCLAMATION NO. 45

**DECLARING TUESDAY, MAY 15, 2001, AS A SPECIAL DAY IN KALOOKAN CITY, METRO MANILA**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the powers vested in it by the Constitution, and the Omnibus Election Code (B.P. 881), the Commission on Elections has resolved to adopt a continuation of the elections in Kalookan City on May 15, 2001;

**WHEREAS**, Tuesday, May 15, 2001, should be declared a special day in Kalookan City for the continuation of elections thereof;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO**, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby declare Tuesday, May 15, 2001, as a special day in Kalookan City, Metro Manila.
