PROCLAMATION NO. 65

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, JULY 4, 2001, AS A SPECIAL DAY IN CADIZ CITY

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the people of Cadiz City be given full opportunity to celebrate this milestone in their city's history with appropriate ceremonies.


