PROCLAMATION NO. 82

DECLARING WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 22, 2001, AS A SPECIAL NON-WORKING DAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LILOY, ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Lilooy will be celebrating its 50th Foundation Day anniversary on Wednesday, August 22, 2001;

WHEREAS, it was on such a date that former President Elpidio Quirino signed Executive Order No. 469, s. 1951, which made Lilooy a Municipality;

WHEREAS, the residents of the Municipality of Lilooy desire to celebrate with fitting ceremonies this event in their town's history;


