**DECLARING TUESDAY, AUGUST 28, 2001, AS A SPECIAL NON-WORKING DAY IN DUMAGUETE CITY**

WHEREAS, the 28<sup>th</sup> day of August 2001 marks the 100<sup>th</sup> founding anniversary of Silliman University, having been established on August 28, 1901;
