WHEREAS, Saturday, January 10, 2004, marks the 64th *Foundation Day Anniversary* of the City of Koronadal, Province of South Cotabato;


WHEREAS, it is fitting that the people of the City of Koronadal be given full opportunity to celebrate the occasion with appropriate ceremonies.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be affixed.


