PROCLAMATION NO. 1868

**DECLARING WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 2009, AS SPECIAL (NON-
WORKING) DAY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBAY**

WHEREAS, Wednesday, September 2, 2009, marks the 144th birth anniversary of the late General Simeon A. Ola, the last revolutionary general to surrender at the end of the Philippine-American War;

WHEREAS, in order to give more meaning and importance to the occasion, it is but fitting and proper to declare September 2, 2009 as special (non-working) day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDUARDO R. ERMITA, Executive Secretary, by authority of Her Excellency, **GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO**, do hereby declare Wednesday, September 2, 2009 as special (non-working) day in the Province of Albay.
