PROCLAMATION NO. 900

DECLARING TUESDAY, 4 NOVEMBER 2014, AS A SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAY IN THE CITY OF SAN CARLOS, NEGROS OCCIDENTAL

**WHEREAS**, Tuesday, 4 November 2014, marks the annual festival of the City of San Carlos, during which activities are held in thanksgiving for the many blessings the City has received;

**WHEREAS**, the National Historical Commission of the Philippines has recommended the declaration of 4 November 2014 as a special day for the City, citing it as the date the City was re-named to San Carlos, from its former name "Nabinkalan," by its then politico-military governor Don Emilio Nuñez Saravia;

**WHEREAS**, it is but fitting and proper that the people of the City of San Carlos, Negros Occidental be given full opportunity to celebrate and participate in the occasion with appropriate ceremonies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, PAQUITO N. OCHOA JR.**, Executive Secretary, by authority of His Excellency, **BENIGNO S. AQUINO III**, do hereby declare Tuesday, 4 November 2014, as a special (non-working) day in the City of San Carlos, Negros Occidental.
