[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7575]

AN ACT CONVERTING THE RURAL HEALTH UNIT IN  
THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAPANG DALAGA, PROVINCE  
OF MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL, INTO A FIVE-BED  
CAPACITY HEALTH INFIRMARY, TO BE KNOWN AS  
THE SAPANG DALAGA HEALTH INFIRMARY, AND  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the  
Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The rural health unit in the Municipality of  
Sapang Dalaga, Province of Misamis Occidental, is hereby converted  
into a five-bed capacity health infirmary, to be known as the  
Sapang Dalaga Health Infirmary.

SEC. 2. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of  
this Act shall be included in the General Appropriations Act of

the year following its enactment into law and thereafter.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
