AN ACT CONVERTING KILING, TANAUAN – TABONTABON – JULITA PROVINCIAL ROAD, PROVINCE OF LEYTE INTO A NATIONAL ROAD


Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:


SECTION 1. The Kiling, Tanauan – Tabontabon – Julita Provincial Road in the second congressional district, Province of Leyte is hereby converted into a national road.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.


