[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 12008]

AN ACT ESTABLISHING AN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN PROGRESSIVE 15, BARANGAY MOLINO 2, CITY OF BACOR, PROVINCE OF CAVITE, TO BE KNOWN AS THE PROGRESSIVE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of Education, an elementary school in Progressive 15, Barangay Molino 2, City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite, to be known as the Progressive Elementary School.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the Progressive Elementary School, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. Within ninety (90) days from the approval of this Act, the Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act. Such

implementing rules and regulations shall provide for the school's organization, administration, operations and management, in accordance with Republic Act No. 9155, or the "Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001", Republic Act No. 10533, or the "Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013", and other basic education-related laws.

SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
